

ATTENDANCE

Students are allowed two absences in the review classes for illness. Students who exceed two absences must make up those absences the week of July 19. For each day absent beyond two, a student must attend one make-up day. There is a cost of \$15 per make-up day for each class.

EVALUATION

Progress reports will be given at the mid-point of the course. At the conclusion of the course, students will receive a mark of A, B, C, D, or F.

DRESS CODE

Dress is casual. Footwear and modest dress are required. The School reserves the right to determine what is proper dress.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted at Mount St. Joseph. Students who smoke in a school building or on school grounds may be asked to withdraw from summer school.

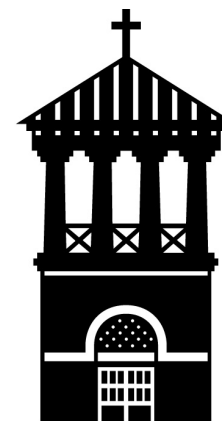

TUITION

Full payment is required by the first day of class.

CALENDAR

Review classes begin on Tuesday, June 15th, and end July 16th. July 5th is a holiday.

Original credit classes begin on June 23rd and end July 30th. July 5th is a holiday.

REGISTRATION

Parents or students with parents' consent may register by mail or in person. Students should be registered by June 11. The registration form should be accompanied with \$25, which will be applied toward tuition and is non-refundable. Please detach the registration form from this brochure when you register.

WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

Students who withdraw during the first week of class will receive one-half of their total tuition bill. Students who withdraw at anytime after the first week of classes will receive no refund. The school reserves the right to dismiss a student and apply these same refund policies.

LOCATION

Mount St. Joseph is located on Frederick Avenue in Baltimore. It is within two miles of the Baltimore Beltway.

ELIGIBILITY

The Summer School Program is open to Catholic and non-public school students.

COURSES

Review Courses are credit courses for students who have failed a course for the regular school year.

Original Credit Courses are credit classes that allow students to acquire new skills and information and are for one full credit.

STUDY SKILLS

This program provides students with practice in the skills necessary for success in high school. Developing a positive attitude, note-taking, test-taking, and time management skills are strongly emphasized. Classes are for one week and are scheduled at different times during the summer school. Call the school for a brochure if you are interested in the study skills class. The fee is \$125.00.

SAT PREP for Verbal Skills is a three week course and is held from June 14 to July 1. Time is 1:00 – 2:00 – Cost is \$150.

TEXTS

Texts may be required for some courses. They must be paid for the first week of summer school. Students will be allowed to rent texts for most classes.
